Forklift Training Guidelines

The checklist below is vital for whichever workplace that has lift trucks on the premises. Each of these questions must be answered with "yes" if all the safety regulations and rules are being followed. A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural flaw that might cause accident, injury or damage to machinery.

- 1) Is the pedestrian traffic separated from the forklift working area?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways provided and well marked?
- 4) A sign is clearly visible stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for operators and pedestrians?
- 6) Alterations or changes to the daily lift truck schedule has been communicated to staff?
- 7) The forklift tires being used are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being used?
- 9) The forklift seat is in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Are yearly checks of the forklift being done?
- 12) Is the type of forklift right for the tasks?
- 13) Is there a readable load chart on the forklift?
- 14) Do all operators understand how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various uses and attachments?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work correctly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured right?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted right on the lift truck?
- 19) Have all forklift operators obtained certification?
- 20) Warning signs and speed limits are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the forklifts being used?
- 22) Do operators know their duties to report any machine damage and lift truck incidents?
- 23) Prior to the machine being operated, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed every day?
