## **Telehandler Training Courses Prince George**

Telehandler Training Courses Prince George - Employers are responsible for making certain that their supervisory and operating personnel are trained to work proficiently utilizing telehandler machinery. The competence level of workers have to be assessed. If deficiencies are found, employers must provide training so that employees obtain the required level of ability. The level of responsibility of the individual should be taken into consideration when training is offered. Effective training will solve any deficiencies in the knowledge, skills and understanding of telehandler operators and supervisors. Training could be undertaken through in-house session or by engaging the services of an external training provider. An assessment at the completion of the training period will determine whether or not the learning goals have been met.

Guidelines and regulations for the basic telehandler operator testing and training are set by state/provincial, local and federal regulators. Basic training does not deal with such subject matters as the lifting of suspended loads, the lifting of persons, making use of other attachments, or the utilization of rotating equipment. Further training will need to be undertaken if such tasks are required on the work site.

## Inspection and maintenance

Similar to whichever machinery, a telehandler needs effective maintenance. The machinery inevitably will suffer wear eventually. Right maintenance is vital to ensuring safe use of the telehandler equipment. Inspections and checks are important to ongoing maintenance measures. Operators should have machine-specific training in order to prevent, rectify and monitor problems associated with deterioration, damage and wear. Workers require experience and competence in both periodic and breakdown maintenance. The preventive maintenance instructions of the manufacturer should be viewed seriously and followed, taking into consideration such factors as frequency of use and environmental conditions in the work setting.

The responsibility for making certain that the telehandler and its attachments are in good working order lies with both the owner and the user of the equipment. General maintenance is usually carried out by the telehandler owner whereas pre-use inspections are normally carried out by the user.
